

Top Tips

Set up a children's account on an Xbox or PlayStation.

If something pops up that isn't for children, shut it off, press x (exit) and tell a grown-up.

Children should use YouTube Kids because it is safer.

Keep your passwords safe and private. Don't write them down or tell a friend.

Use a long complicated password including, numbers, symbols, lower case and capital letters.

Do not accept friend requests or play with people you don't know online.

Always use different passwords for each device.

Don't use your real name, address or phone numbers when playing games online.

Turn location off to hide where you are.

If in doubt, don't click.

Don't put details in sites which are not secure. Look for the padlock in the URL bar to make sure.

Tell an adult if you're worried about anything online.
