

Computing

We will be learning how to use email; how to send messages, add pictures or files, and be a good friend online by using kind words and knowing how to stay safe from bullies and tricky messages.

We will also be learning how to become a great programmer in Scratch; understand the code blocks, make loops, improve existing programs, and learn how to find and fix mistakes in your code.

RE

In the first half term, the children will be looking at which rules people follow and how this may vary depending upon faith.

In the second half term, the children will look at the Easter story.

French

We will learn to speak about birthdays and dates in French while comparing our festivals to French traditions. We will also use dictionaries to build wish lists and become a "grammar detective" by discovering how nouns and adjectives work together.

Science

We will be learning how to become a sound expert! We will learn how sounds are made by things shaking (vibrating), that these vibrations move through the air to reach our ears, and that you can make sounds higher or lower (pitch) and louder or quieter (volume) by changing how fast or how strong the vibrations are.

Music

We will continue learning how to play the recorder. We will be moving onto notes F, E & D. We will be learning how to play simple tunes with notes of long and short duration.

PSHE

Being Safe:

In this unit, we are going to learn how to stay safe and make smart choices, especially when using the internet. You will discover how to spot and avoid risks and why following rules keeps us safe.

Relationships:

We will be learning how to build and enjoy healthy, positive relationships while staying safe and respected. We will also discover how to recognise different types of relationships and understand the importance of personal boundaries.

The Roman Empire and Ancient Greece

Geography

This term we will be looking at the world of the Ancient Greeks and Romans from the Mediterranean and beyond to the shores of Britain in the North, to the Afghan mountains in the East.

Art/DT

In Art, we will plan and create an abstract sculpture based on the Romans.

In DT, we will create an illuminated notice board linked to the Ancient Greeks.

PE

Fitness: we are going to explore all the amazing things our body can do by learning about different areas of fitness. We will have fun developing our speed and strength, while also practicing our co-ordination, agility, and stamina to become a more confident and active mover.

History

The first half term will look at the world of the Ancient Greek civilisations. We begin with the Minoans on Crete, then onto the Mycenaean world and mythical tales of Gods and men. Two weeks will be spent on the Classical period, looking at the rise of the city states and their profound impact upon the modern world. We will conclude with The Hellenistic Age and the conquests of Alexander the Great and his legacy.

The second half of the term will focus on the Romans. From their origins shrouded in myth, to the rise of the Republic, the Imperial age, and the impact and legacy of the Romans upon Celtic Britain.
