### Dear Families,

Welcome to the penultimate Newsletter of Autumn 2 as we are fast approaching the Christmas holidays. I hope you have plans for a joyous festive break with your loved ones. This Sunday marks the season of Advent and our advent wreath reminds us of the key messages of Peace, Love, Joy and Hope, with Jesus at the centre.
